Our purpose is to provide an opportunity for young men and women to learn the game of Football, develop sportsmanship, citizenship and create lifelong fans of the game we all love. Players, Parents/Guardians and Coaches are expected to review and sign the Code of Conduct (CoC) prior to their participation at any White Bear Youth Football Association (WBYPF) sanctioned event. Any violation of the COC may result in temporary or permanent banishment from White Bear Youth Football Events.

Code of Conduct - Player and Coach

1. Regulations

- a. I will learn the White Bear Youth Football Association mission policies and rules of the game.
- b. I will respect and adhere to the rules governing eligibility and competition.
- c. I will follow all health and safety guidelines published by the WBYPF.
- d. I will respect and adhere to the rules governing eligibility and competition.

2. Conduct

- a. I will not use profanity.
- b. I will treat players, coaches, fans and officials with respect and not discriminate regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.
- c. I will not berate the officials or "trash talk" to my opponent or their fans and treat other players, coaches, fans and Referees with respect
- d. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all WBYPF sporting events.
- e. I will respect the volunteers that are assisting with the conduct of these events.
- f. I will not physically or verbally assault players, coaches, officials, parents or anyone at a WBYPF event.
- g. I will express my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.

3. Attitude

- a. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every game.
- b. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my teammates and opponents ahead of my personal desire to win.
- c. I will do my best to remember that youth sports are supposed to be FUN and that winning and losing are part of everyone's experience.

All those subject to this COC are also subject to any league rules and codes of conduct to include, but not limited to, MEYFL and MSHSL. Individuals observed violating these Policies may be subject to review by WBYPF Conduct Committee. Any Conduct committee review is subject to disciplinary action that could include but not limited to, Warning, Suspension of team activities or games and/or Dismissal from the WBYPF organization.
